  - « Appoint TPA

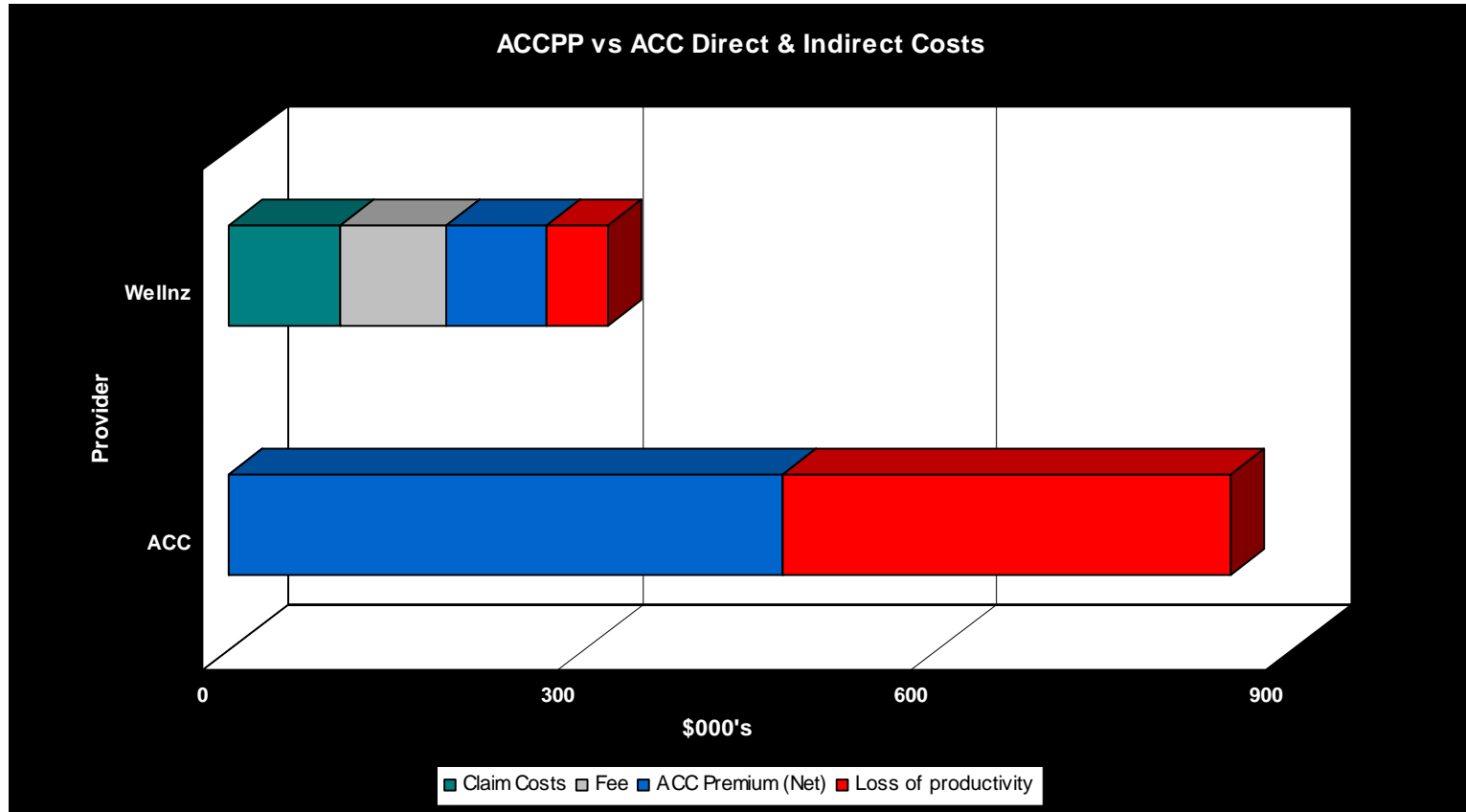
# The Value Proposition

- Being employee focused
- Productivity and Service gains
- Treating claimants with dignity and respect

# Withdrawing from ACCPP

- Obtain all the facts to make informed decision
- Need to consider:
  - « Cost to Benefit analysis
  - « Direct and Indirect costs
  - « The ACC scenario
  - « Increase in:
    - \* days lost
    - \* Administration
    - \* Premiums – over time

# ACC Performance

- Entitlement Claims – 2006/07
  - ACC - \$13,808 - 58 days (est.)
  - TPA - \$ 1,761 - 11 days

# Example

- Under ACC direct management 1998/99
  - « Staff 2,500
  - « Levy \$3m
  - « Claims \$2m
- Under ACCPP 2006/07
  - « Staff 5,700
  - « Total costs \$350,000
  - « Claims \$150,000

# Other matters to consider

- National Government
  - « What will it mean

- Effective management of your people
  - « How important is it to you ???
