### Speaker Biography

Dr Courtenay Kenny undertook his medical training in Auckland, and his formal specialist training in occupational medicine in both the UK (1991-93) and in New Zealand (1994-96).

He has 20 years of experience in occupational medicine, including 17 years with the Royal New Zealand Navy

Over the last ten years Dr Kenny has been the specialist occupational physician for Waitemata District Health Board (North Shore and Waitakere Hospitals).

Dr Kenny also has a private consultant practice in occupational medicine in Auckland, and is an honorary senior lecturer in the Occupational Medicine Unit, Faculty of Medicine and Health Science, University of Auckland.

Previous appointments have included;

- Visiting lecturer at Simon Fraser University in Vancouver, Canada (1990/1),
- Deputy Principal Medical Officer at the Rosyth Royal Dockyard in Scotland (1992/3)
- Senior Medical Officer with the United Nations Special Commission (UNSCOM) in Baghdad, Iraq (1994)
- Director of Medical Services for the Royal New Zealand Navy (1995-97).

Dr Kenny is a Fellow of the Australasian Faculty of Occupational Medicine (1997), and an Associate of the Royal College of Physicians Faculty of Occupational Medicine (1993) (UK).

Dr Kenny's interests are in the aetiology and management of chronic musculo-skeletal pain, the relationship of stress and other psycho-social factors to musculo-skeletal pain, and injury rehabilitation.
