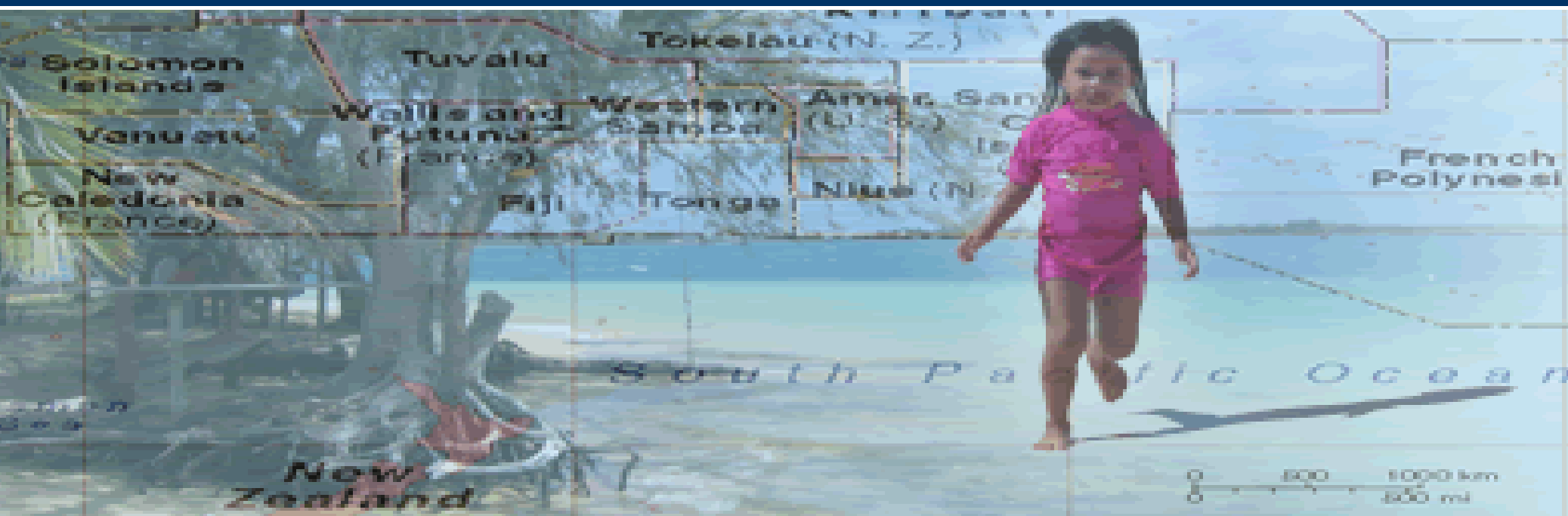

# Background of Need

**A Study\* tabling “Proportion of deaths and inpatient hospitalisations that mention diabetes, 45-64 year old residents of Counties Manukau, 2000-2003 “**

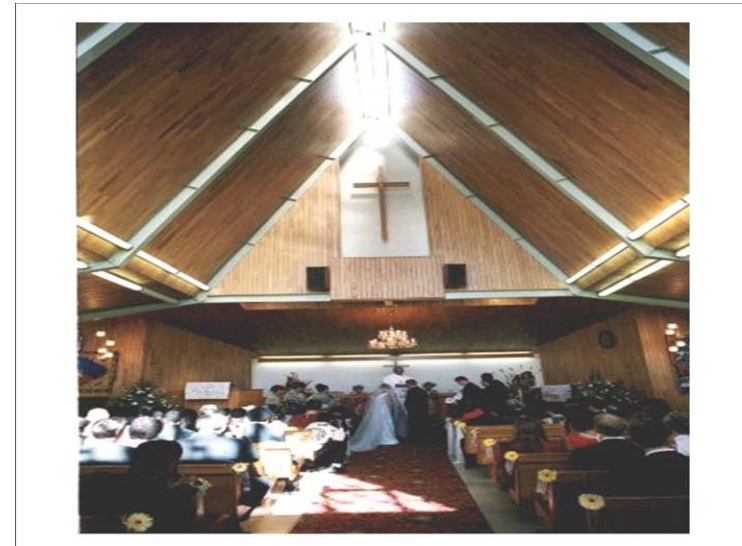
- 25% of deaths 45-64 year old Pacific diabetes related
- Maori mortality rates 21%, Asian 6% and European Other 4%.
- **Different profiles in morbidity-mortality** - 38% pacific discharges related to diabetes versus Asian 21% yet mortality rates show significant gap.
